- Before & After Care: Available from 8:00 AM 5:00 PM for an additional fee

#### **Tuition & Fees**

- Weekly Tuition: \$200 per student
- Full Summer Tuition: \$1400 per student
- Before & After Care: \$50 per week
- Registration Fee: \$50 (non-refundable)
- Discounts: 10% off for Military, first responders, and school employees

## **Program Activities**

# **Policies & Procedures**

## Attendance & Absences

- Students are expected to attend regularly to fully benefit from the program.
- Parents must notify staff at least 24 hours in advance if a student will be absent.
- No refunds or credits are provided for missed days.

# Drop-Off & Pick-Up

- Drop-Off: Begins at 9:45 AM
- Pick-Up: Promptly at 3:00 PM unless enrolled in aftercare
- Late Pick-Up Fee: \$10 per 15 minutes after 3:00 PM
- Only authorized individuals listed on the student's registration form will be allowed to pick up the child.

## **Behavior & Conduct**

To ensure a safe and respectful learning environment, students must:

- Show kindness and respect to peers and staff
- Follow all safety instructions and activity guidelines
- Engage positively in group activities



#### **Discipline Process**

- 1. Verbal warning and redirection
- 2. Parent notification
- 3. Suspension or removal if behavior persists

# Health & Safety

• Allergies & Dietary Needs: Parents must notify staff of any allergies. Snacks and meals should be nut-free.

• Sick Policy: Children must be symptom-free for 24 hours before returning.

• Emergency Preparedness: Staff are CPR & first-aid trained, and the facility is equipped with video surveillance and secure access controls.

# **Field Trip Policies**

- Field trips are included in tuition, but some locations may require additional waivers.
- Students must wear designated summer program T-shirts on field trip days.
- Transportation will be provided by staff or chartered services.

## **Registration & Cancellation**

- First-come, first-served basis spaces are limited!
- A non-refundable deposit secures your child's spot.
- If a family chooses to withdraw, a two-week written notice is required.
